Driver's Education Offered to High School Students

(Funded by Volusia County Council through the Slosberg Fund)

Fall Programs

Registration for the Fall Driver's Education programs will begin on Tuesday, August 23, 2011. Students interested in earning credit in Driver's Education during the fall semester must pick up a registration form from the school's guidance office beginning on August 22, complete it with signatures and return to the school registrar, along with a copy of their learner's permit. Registration will occur on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment is limited based upon available slots. Students must have a learner's permit in order to participate in the program. There is no fee for the program. Closed toe shoes are required. Students will earn a ½ credit upon successful course completion. If they pass the road test administered by our drivers' education teachers who are third party testers, they will receive a paperless waiver for an operator's license through the DMV.

The Fall 2011 After School Driver's Education School Program will begin on Tuesday, September 6, 2011, and will run through Thursday, December 13. Classes will be held from 4:00-6:30 Tuesdays & Thursdays of each week.

The Fall 2011 Saturday Driver's Education School Program will begin on Saturday, September 10, 2011, and will run through Saturday, November 12, 2011. Classes will be held each Saturday from 8:00 a.m.-3:15 p.m. Students will have 30 minutes for lunch. Students will not be allowed to leave campus for lunch, therefore, they should bring their lunch. Drink and snack machines may be available on school sites.

Eligibility requirements for the program:

- Must be currently enrolled and must have previously completed one full year of high school
- Must be 15 years or older on or before the first day of the session for which the student is enrolled
- Must have and present a restricted license/learner's permit on the first day of the session for which the student is enrolled (learner's permit is also required in order to register for the program)
- Must not have already received credit for driver's education or have a permanent drivers license
